Subject: Printer Consolidation Project Update

Per directives from CMS and the Governor's Office IMSA is moving forward with the print consolidation plan approved by CMS last fiscal year. This year we will be installing new high speed devices intended for multi=location, network use in selected areas based on cost savings and addressing issues with current printers and multi-function devices. The first two of the four devices will be delivered and enabled for staff and student use in the next couple of weeks. Meetings have been scheduled with the departments most affected by the installation of these new devices.

Please understand that the installation of these new devices does not mean the immediate removal of working printers. The new devices are more cost effective so departments will be encouraged to use them as their primary printing device.
